

Voters Bill of Rights



Each registered voter in this state has the right to:

- Vote and have his or vote accurately counted.
- Cast a vote if he or she is **IN LINE** when the polls close at 8:00pm
- Receive assistance in voting if so listed the register or is visibly handicapped.
- Show proof of identity by presenting a photo ID.
- May be required to fill out an address confirmation form.
- Complete and sign an affidavit in order to vote. If his or her registration is in question
- An explanation if his or her registration is in question.
- Vote free from coercion or intimidation by elections officers or any other person.
- Vote on a voting system that is in working condition and that will allow votes to be accurately cast.
- A MAXIMUM OF 3 MINUTES IN THE VOTING MACHINE.**
- Bring a sample ballot into the voting booth.
- Contact the registrar of voters for registration verification.
