ORDER

Upon presentation to the court that the Parish of St. John the Baptist will be observing a holiday on Monday, February 12, 2024, the day before Mardi Gras, by virtue of inclusion of that day upon the Parish President's list of 2024 Parish Holidays [attached], with all public buildings ordered closed; and

That to maintain the courthouse open without necessary support staff and security would render an unsafe or hazardous environment for courthouse employees as well as the general public; and


That the courts will be closed on Monday, February 12, 2024,

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the St. John the Baptist Parish courthouse in Edgard shall be closed commencing on Monday, February 12, 2024, and for the entire day of February 13, 2024, when the court buildings shall remain closed, pursuant to the provisions of LSA-R.S 1:55(A)3

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Office of the Clerk of Court shall publicize said closures as feasible and shall post conspicuously emergency contact and filing information; the Office of the Clerk of Court shall continue to accept facsimile filings on February 12, and 13, 2024.

The court house buildings shall re-open on Wednesday, February 14, 2024.
